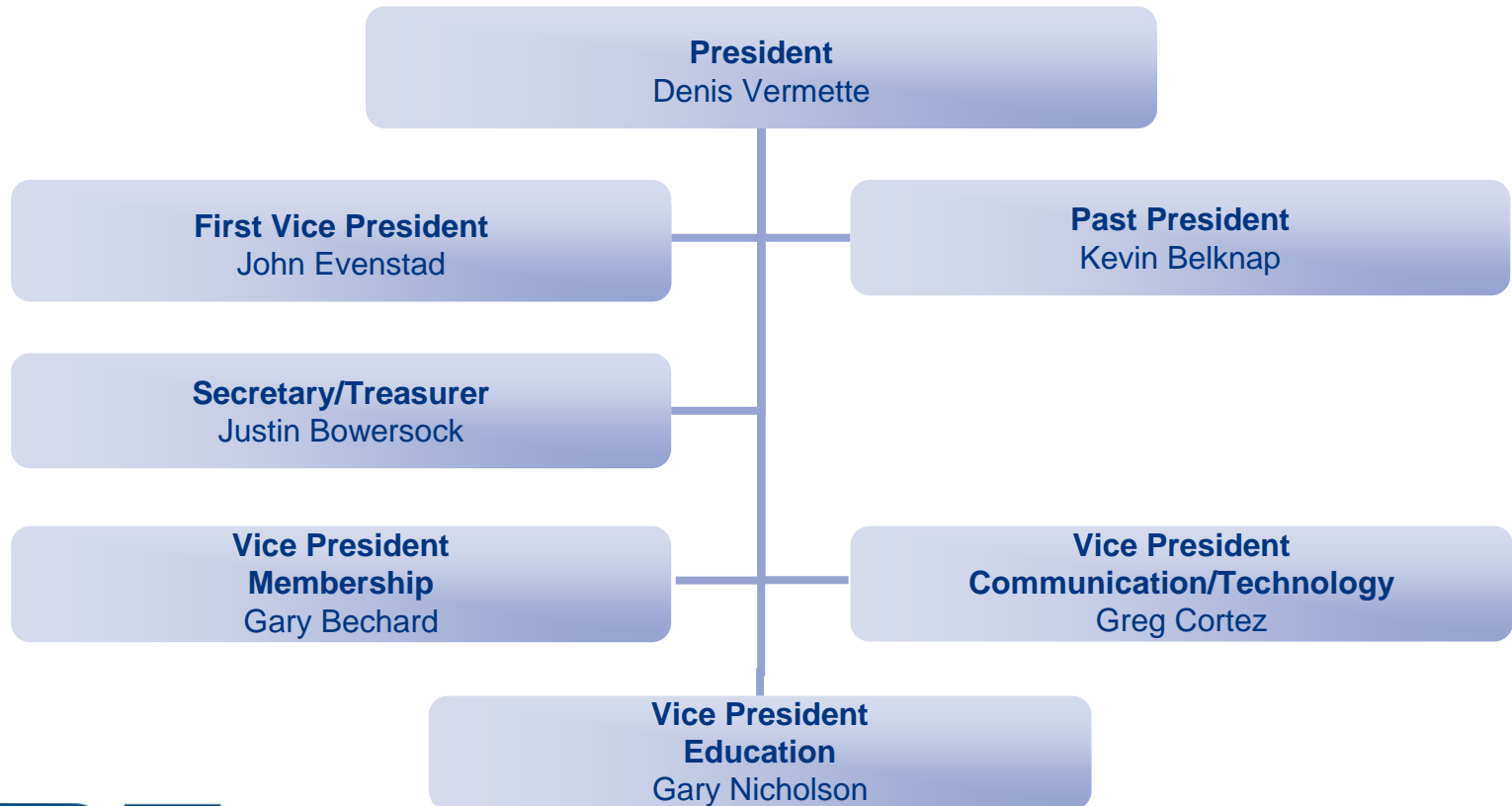




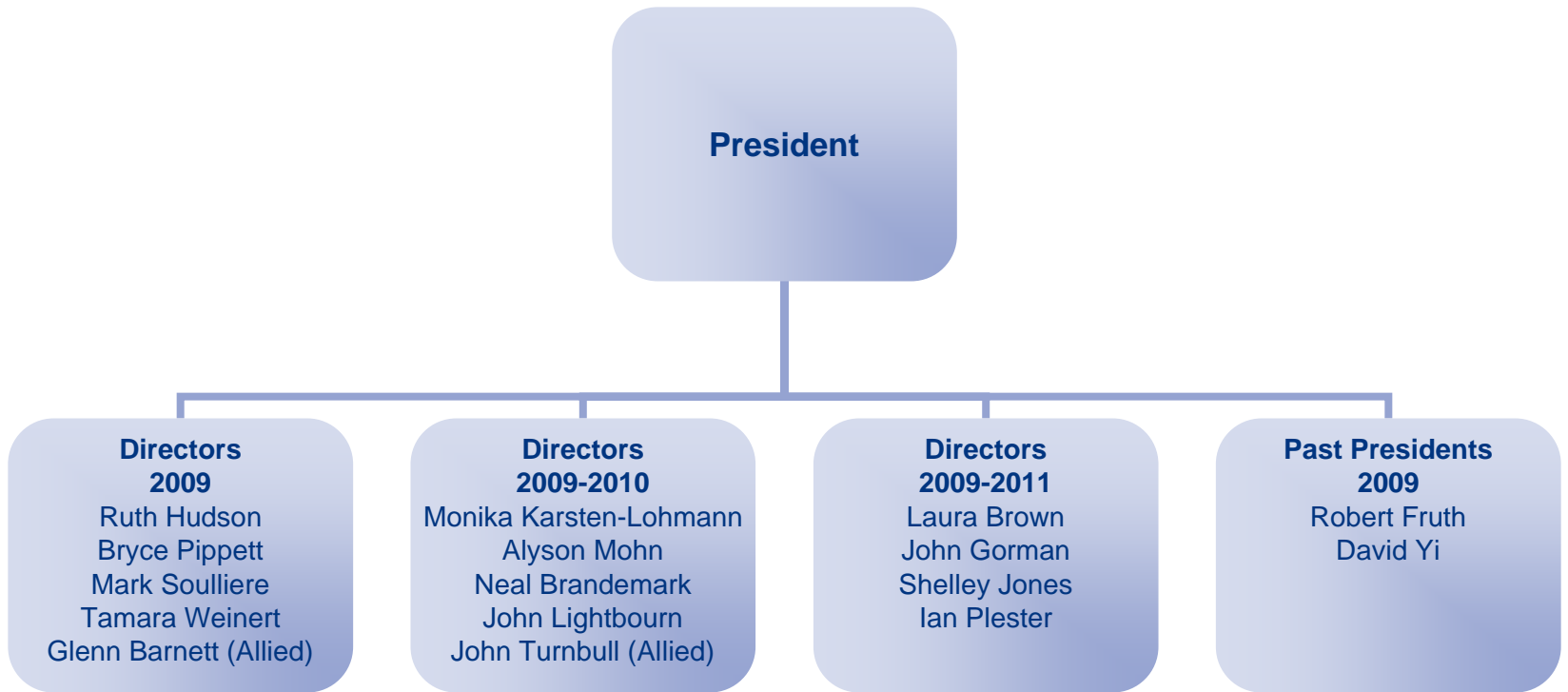

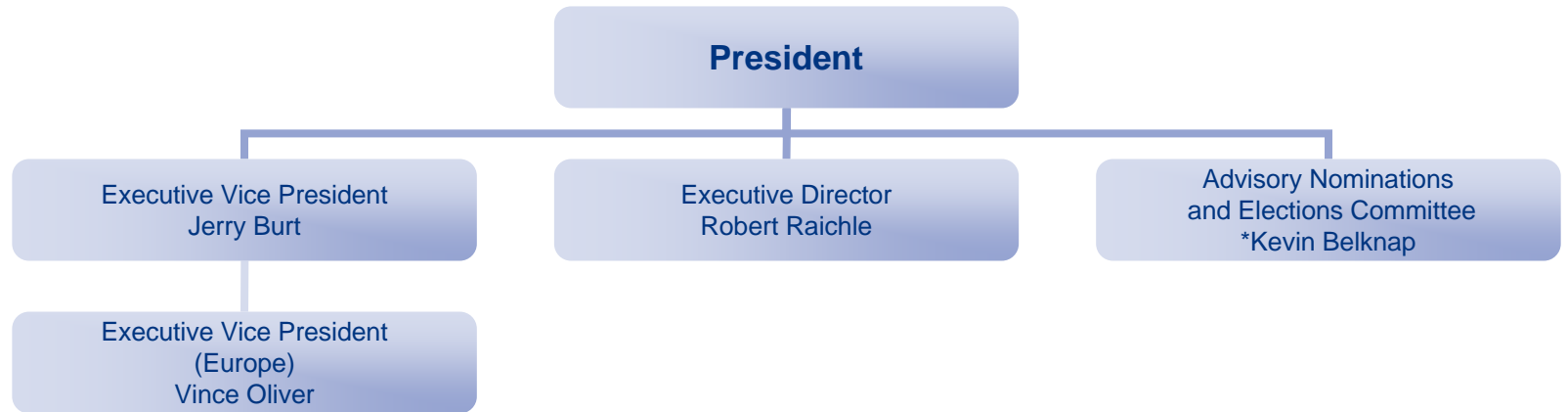
Officers & Vice Presidents



Directors & Past Presidents



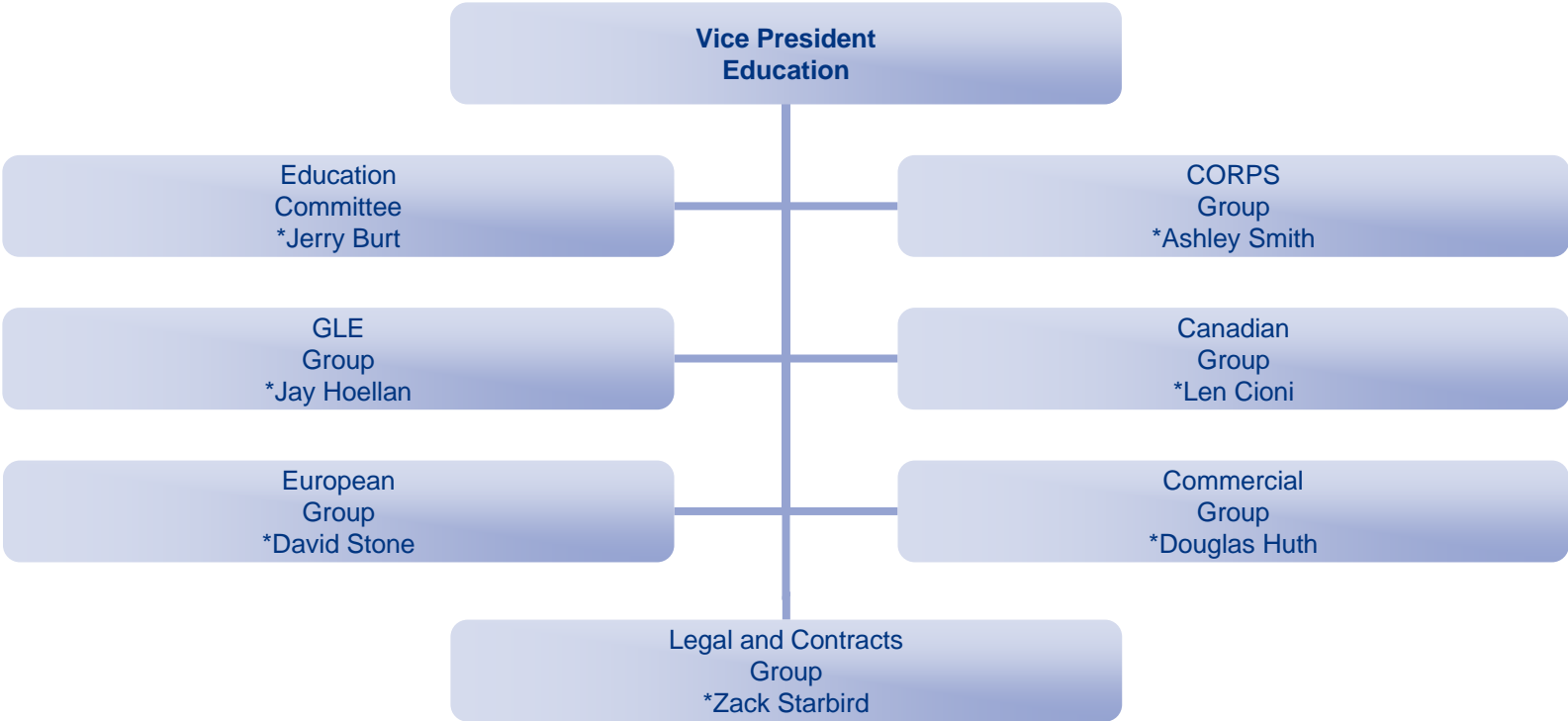
President

Vice President - Education

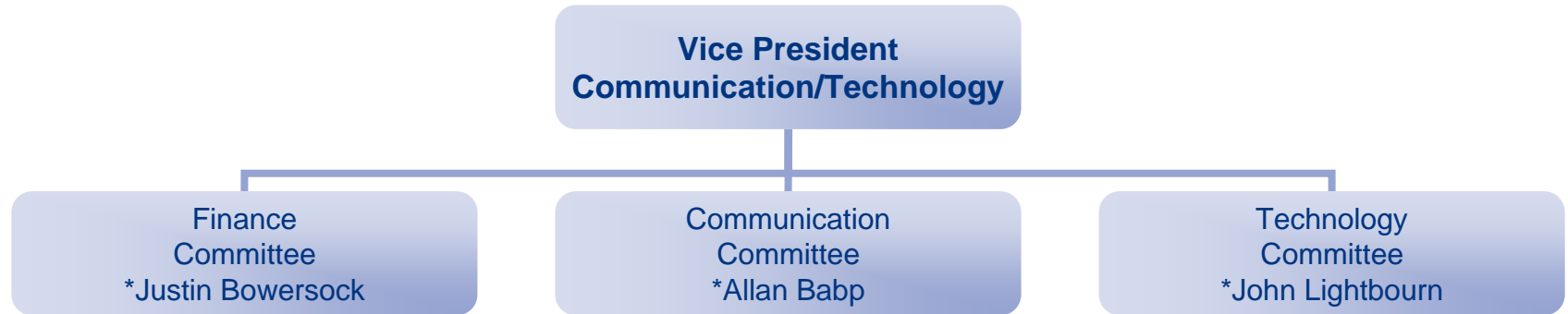

Directors

- The Board of Directors shall have general charge over management and control of the funds, property and activities of this Association and shall authorize and control expenditures and shall determine policies which will specify the extent of the authority granted to Officers and Committee Chairpersons
